From striking a balance between IP rights protection and public policy to promoting IP rights education, Indian legislature has made efforts to implement better IP rights enforcement and protection. Judiciary has not been far behind in contributing to the development of **IP rights**. Litigation regarding trademarks, copyrights and patents has set new precedents, with the Indian courts adopting international principles and rulings to protect IP rights in order to deter infringers.

In this seminar he had provided the participants with an understanding in IP laws and the extent to which it protects inventions and designs.

### **The objectives of the seminar are:**

1. To raise **awareness** on the issues of intellectual property and their violations.
2. To identify **educational and social strategies** to address the issue.
3. To collect, share and **develop innovative responses** and best practices for elimination and prevention of violation of intellectual property rights.
4. To give recommendations and concrete proposals for action for elimination and prevention of crimes related with intellectual property.

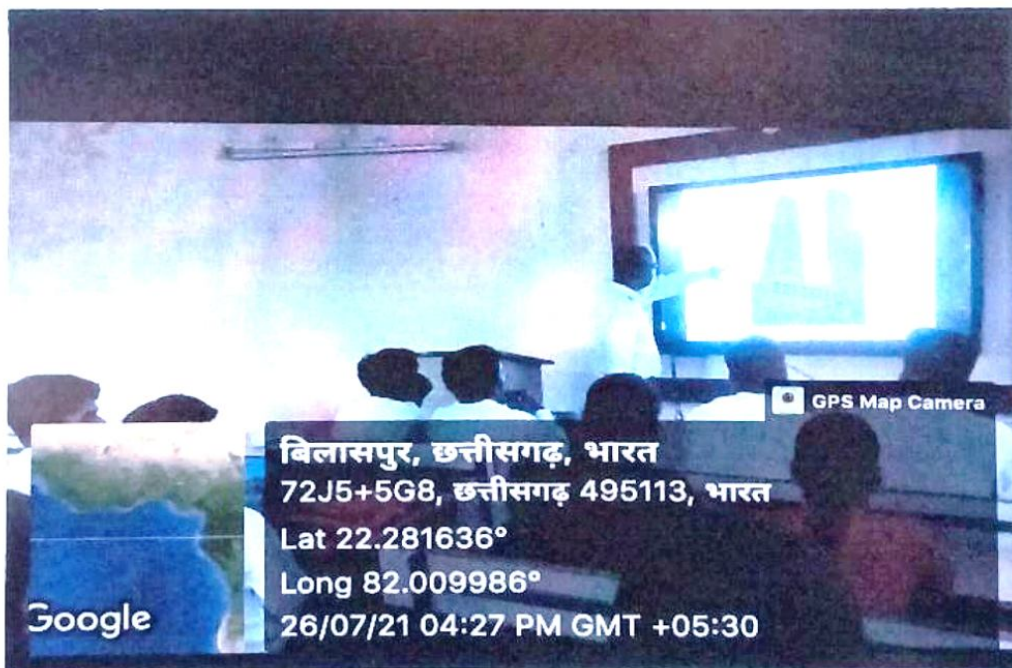
