**Brief Report-**

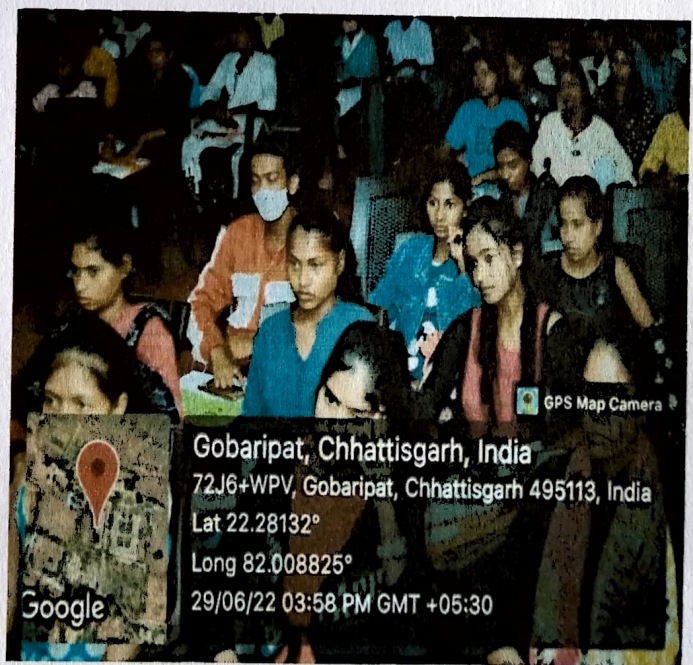
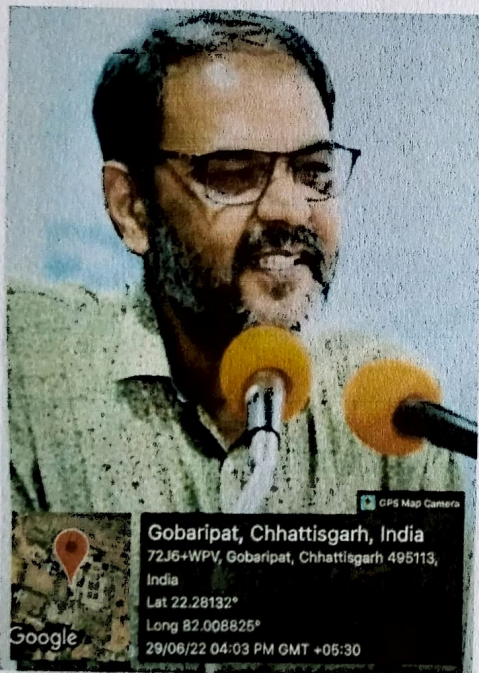

They allow their owner to completely benefit from his/her product which was initially an idea that developed and crystallized. They also entitle him/her to prevent others from using, dealing or tampering with his/her product without prior permission from him/her.”

With the same spirit, Expert Talk was conducted on the theme “**RELEVANCE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS(IPR) IN ACADEMICS**” On 29<sup>th</sup> June 2022 for the Students of the Department of Social Science, Faculty of Arts, Dr. C.V.
