Brief report on faculty exchange program

The main objective of the seminar was to deliver knowledge to students about gender justice and its legal provision, the progress of the knowledge and make society sensible about gender discrimination. Session was delivered by Miss. Sushma Tiwari, Asst. professor D.P. Vipra Law College, Bilaspur (C.G.) A total of 68 students participated in this session.

The session was inaugurated with the welcome of invited guest Asst. prof. Miss Sushma Tiwari, D.P. Vipra Law College, Bilaspur (C.G.) After the inauguration, all the participants were welcomed by Dr. R. P. Choudhary, Dean Faculty of Law. After this Miss Sushma Tiwari discussed the objectives and outline of the session.

At the beginning of session she highlighted that the Constitution provides equal status to women and a 'positive discrimination' in favour of women. It is time that we recognize and appreciate the reproductive as well as productive role each woman plays in a society and break from the patriarchal secondary status that is given to

women.

Next, domestic violence, pre-birth elimination of females and sexual violence are among the top three most common problems faced by women in the country, she said.

Further, she advocated for the transgender community and for equality and justice. Even while the constitution guarantees all genders equal rights, according to her, they are not even seen in society as belonging to a certain "gender." She brought up the fact that transgender people are still ridiculed and ejected from venues even though Kerala was the first state in India to introduce a transgender legislation. Violence against the transgender community is not challenged and is treated as if it does not exist, even though it is a right guaranteed by the Constitution and the judiciary. She urged people to at least think of them as "Human Beings" in her closing remarks.

The vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. J. K. Patel, Head of the department. The seminar came to an end at 2:00 p.m. Students from B.A.LL.B., B.Com.LL.B., LL.B. and LL.M. in the seminar and was a grand success.

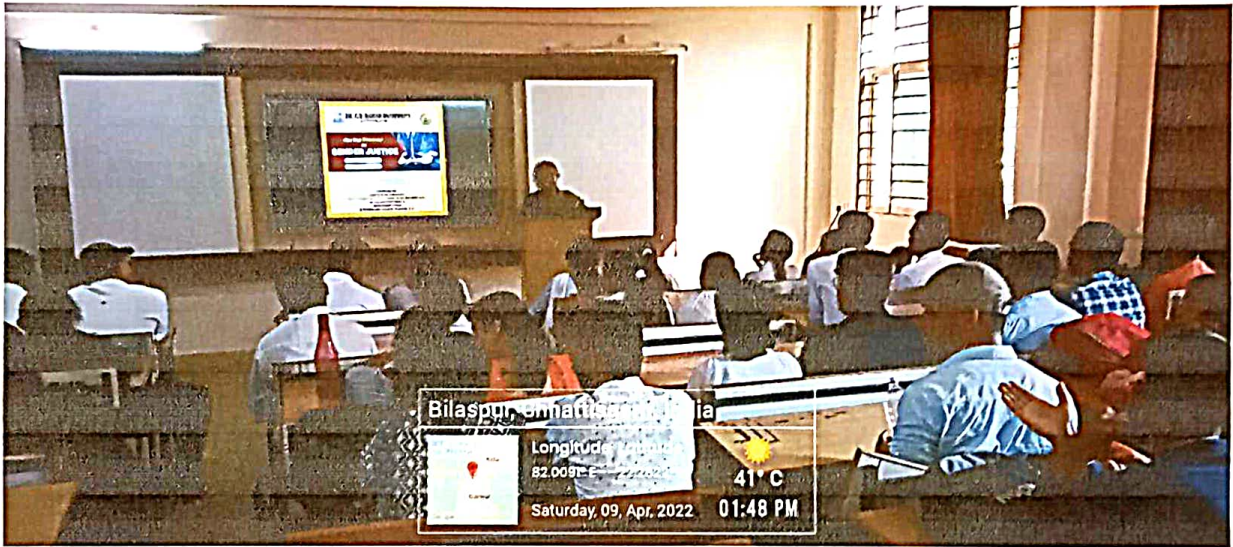


Figure 2: Students attending the awareness programme
